What ever the reason for your dissatisfaction, there are many different ways East Yorkshire Dental Studios can help to improve your smile using modern cosmetic dentistry. Cosmetic dentistry can help with minor aesthetic changes or complete smile make overs.

Cosmetic dentistry involves dental procedures with the aim of improving the overall aesthetics of your smile. Cosmetic dental procedures may include, teeth whitening, veneers, white fillings, Implants and dental bridges.

Tooth Whitening

Teeth whitening can brighten your smile, the colour of your teeth can be significantly improved. Our Home whitening system is the simplest of cosmetic treatments. Impressions of your teeth are taken in the practice, from this bespoke trays are designed especially for you. A whitening kit is created for you, which includes the whitening gel and your trays. A small amount of whitening gel is placed in each tooth of the tray and then the tray is placed over your teeth. Whitening is usually carried out overnight for 2 weeks until the desired tooth shade is reached. Tooth whitening can significantly brighten and whiten your smile.



White Fillings

White fillings are becoming increasingly popular for health as well as cosmetic reasons. Advances in dental materials now allow us to carry out natural tooth coloured fillings rather than traditional black amalgam restorations. These mercury-free composite fillings enable us to return your tooth back to its original shape and colour. White fillings are good for restoring teeth and look great too! White fillings are used to restore teeth after any decay has been removed or they can be used for cosmetic improvements. These composite fillings also provide strength to the surrounding natural tooth.





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Veneers

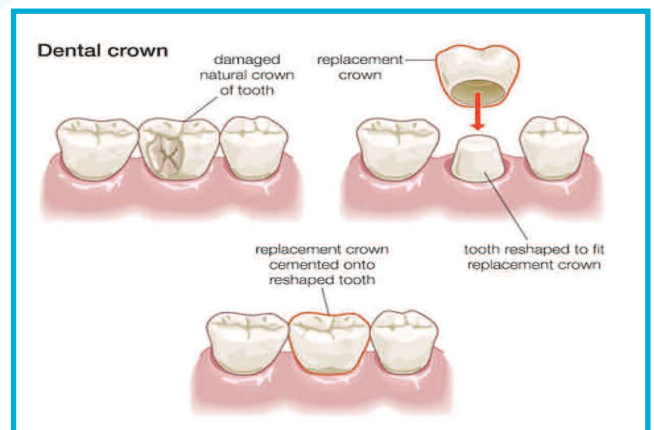
Veneers can be used to give you a perfect, beautiful and straight smile. They allow us to create the stunning smile you have always wanted and can transform your look.

Veneers are fine porcelain shells applied to the outer surface of teeth, they are individually hand-crafted to give you a beautiful, natural smile. Veneers are perfect for improving the appearance of irregularly shaped teeth or covering severe discolouration. Veneers can be used to give a smile make over by changing the shape, colour and alignment of teeth. They are especially useful for covering stains, closing gaps, hiding defects and straightening teeth.



Crowns

Crowns allow a broken down or fractured tooth to be restored with a tooth coloured cap. Removing the need for large metal restorations. If a tooth is badly broken down a crown can be made to restore the tooth back to its original function. Some preparation to the tooth is required, then an impression is taken, the dental laboratory are then sent specific instructions to produce a crown. An appointment is then arranged for the crown to be cemented in place with a special adhesive.





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Dental Bridges

Dental bridges are a false tooth anchored on adjacent teeth in order to replace one or more missing teeth. Unlike removable dentures, a dental bridge is permanent. There are different types of dental bridges which can be placed, the type of bridge used will depend on the quality of the teeth either side of the gap, as well as the position of the gap.

Fixed Bridges

With a fixed bridge, the false tooth (pontic) is anchored to new crowns attached to the teeth either side of the gap. This requires preparation to the retaining teeth.



Maryland Bridges

These bridges do not involve crowning adjacent teeth. The new tooth is attached via metal wings bonded to the adjacent teeth using a special adhesive. This dental bridge maybe particularly useful for front teeth where stress is minimal.



Cantilever Bridges

These dental bridges are used when there is a healthy tooth only on one side of the gap. Therefore the bridge is anchored to only one tooth. As a result this type of dental bridge is only suitable for low stress areas.
